The American Journey Experience came to life in 2022. We took the American Journey Experience on the road for the first time by hosting families from across the nation in Gettysburg, PA.

We brought artifacts to various educational conferences, from Arizona to Florida, to expand the awareness of the American Journey Experience and teach true history. We hosted and equipped teachers, college

students, pastors, and legislators at our training center to know America's founding values and apply them in their own communities and work. We have grown our artifact collection, including obtaining the largest privately owned collection of Pilgrim Century artifacts in the world. It is powerful to see individuals across our nation confident in their knowledge of American history and equipped to defend our nation's founding values.

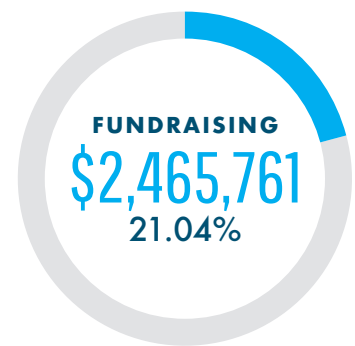
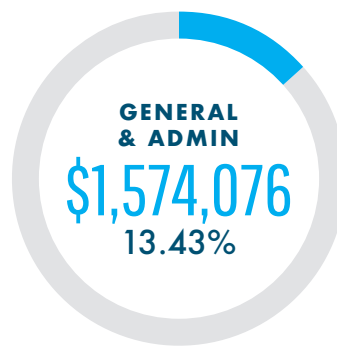
